The world's largest ball of twine is proudly displayed in downtown Darwin, Minn. Constructed by Francis A. Johnson between 1950 and 1979, the ball weights about 11 tons. It is 11 feet tall; 12 feet, 9 inches wide and has a circumference of 40 feet. Drive the 65 miles west on Hwy. 12 today and you can take part in Twine Ball Days.
